

IACR Carer's Bursary– Application Form

Details of the grant:

The Irish Association for Cancer Research is proud to announce the IACR annual Conference Carer's Bursary to support attendance at the 2023 IACR meeting on **Wednesday 22nd – Friday 24th February 2023** in Athlone. This annual conference, which runs over 3 days, with the programme including state-of-the-art research from leading Irish and international researchers. Details are available at <https://www.iacr.ie>.

The IACR Carer's Bursary provides funding of up to €300 to support members to attend the annual meeting with the aim of contributing towards the additional costs of care while attending the conference. We recognise that many of our members have caring responsibilities, which can discourage and exclude members from attending the annual meeting due to lack of provision for the extra costs associated with this. In our commitment to promoting inclusion and to making our annual event accessible to all our members, we are offering up to 5 bursaries for caring costs.

Terms & conditions

To be eligible to apply:

- Applicants must be IACR members and be in good standing with their annual subscriptions when applying for and receiving the grant
- The grant must be used towards the costs associated with additional care for person/people that the applicant cares for, i.e. not care that would be in place irrespective of the meeting.
- It should be noted that the grant is not intended to cover the full costs of care and applicants are encouraged to obtain additional funding from elsewhere as required.
- Applications must be submitted, via email to info@iacr.ie, no later than **15th February 2023**, though earlier application is strongly advised. Please include "Carer's Bursary" in the subject
- Applications are awarded on a first come, first served basis. If successful, applicants will be informed as soon as possible, and they will then need to register for meeting before being issued with a grant.
- Applications will be processed in date order from when they are received, with 5 grants available and with only one application per member allowed.
- The grant award will be up to a maximum of €300 per applicant and will be paid after the meeting.
- Incomplete or late applications will not be considered.
